

SUMMARY WISDOM ON LEGACY PRAYER

GOD DRAWS CLOSE TO US

God freely created us in love to share in His own life. He continuously draws close to us, inviting us to seek, know, and love Him fully.

CONNECTION AND ATTACHMENT PRAYER IN SCRIPTURE

We can see in Scripture that our ancestors demonstrated a deep connection with God through prayer, by referencing His miracles linked to their lineage (like the parting of the Red Sea). This was their personal legacy of gratitude for God's power in their lives and the lives of their ancestors.

They give praise that they are seen, heard, known and loved by God. They reciprocate back to Him that they see, hear, know, and love Him. This is attachment prayer, and we too have the authority to pray this way.

LEGACY PRAYER STIRRING UP FAITH, HOPE, & LOVE

Imagine ourselves and our families contemplating and speaking of God's miracles in gratitude regularly. Imagine us knowing God's names and titles and calling them out from memory. We would be forming ourselves and our loved ones to praise God, BEFORE we ask for anything more, stirring up our virtues of faith, hope, and love.

WHAT IS LEGACY PRAYER IMPACT?

#1 ~ Our peace and joy is increased. Even when we feel like we are failing, we remember that the Trinity dwells within us; It is not up to us alone. We trust and believe that God sees, hears, knows, and loves most especially in the cracks of where we may fail.

#2 ~ We can embrace calm in the countdown. When God doesn't answer our prayer immediately; it is much easier to remain miracle expectant.

#3 ~ It deepens our confidence in God. We come to Him, NOT as a stranger, a slave or a desperate victim. We lift our hearts up to God confidently as His beloved daughter. When we know WHO He is and WHO we are to Him, we can ask in great faith for MORE. Our God is a God of abundance.

Legacy Prayer acts as a guiding compass to Jesus. We are continually reminding ourselves and our loved ones who God is and what He has done in our lives. Our lives are filled with gratitude, wonder and awe. This is how we live out our Legacy of Love.

WELCOME TO THE STEPS OF LEGACY PRAYER

1 STEP ONE ~ IDENTIFY OUR MIRACLES

- We invite the Holy Spirit to reveal five miracles.
- Write each miracle in a separate box.
- Questions (below) may help spark our memory.

1. Have you ever felt a profound presence of God—whether through prayer, Adoration, Scripture, the Sacraments, an act of charity, or in the beauty of nature?
2. Has God answered a prayer that you believed would remain unanswered?
3. Have you (or a loved one) experienced miraculous protection?
4. Have you (or a loved one) received healing in a miraculous manner?
5. Has God provided financially or in another unexpected way?
6. Has God offered you clarity with a challenging decision?
7. Has God triumphed over evil or sin in your life?
8. Has God provided guidance or comfort during a difficult period?

2 STEP TWO ~ SELECT A TITLE TO GIVE GRATITUDE

- Choose a title that gives gratitude for this miracle.
- Write each title in the corresponding box.

3 STEP THREE ~ CHOOSE FIVE PRAYER INTENTIONS

- We do not allow anxiety or worry to dull our hearts.
- We lovingly and confidently entrust our heart to God by choosing five prayer intentions.
- Write each intention in a separate box.

4 STEP FOUR ~ CHOOSE A TITLE FOR ANTICIPATED MIRACLE

- There are no wrong choices; all of God's names and titles are truly wonderful.
