VIRTUE TRAIN

VINCENTIAN VIRTUE

St. Vincent de Paul's followers lived virtuously, and we are called to do the same.

Cardinal Virtues ~ prudence, justice, fortitude, and temperance

VIRTUE IN ACTION

God calls us to embrace our virtue and reflect His glory.

3 Aspects of Virtue Growth ~ Education, Deliberate Acts, and Perseverance in Struggle.

Mortification Application Ideas ~ Fast from actions, foods, or activities that you enjoy . . . Plan-Do-Reflect-Adjust weekly . . . Do not procrastinate. Stay with the same task until completed.

Humility Application Ideas ~ Acknowledge the gifts of others; praise God for them . . . Show deference to the opinions/desires of others over your own . . . Stop lying, even tiny lies.

Meekness Application Ideas ~ Be open to asking and receiving help from others . . . Surrender daily, "Jesus, I surrender myself to You. Take care of everything" . . . Tolerate inconvenience without complaint and forgive quickly.
